Felton Road is part of a growing band of top wine producers who put their environmental responsibilities high on the list of their priorities. The most tangible recent example of this is the installation of an array of solar panels on the winery roof in a bid to become self-sufficient in energy, and the addition of an electric car to its fleet.

The producer, best known for its Central Otago Pinot Noir, produces only in the region of 12,000 cases each year and pursues a zero growth policy. It intends to make no more in future vintages and doesn't have, or need, a marketing budget because all wines go on allocation.

"I have long believed any great brand is based on truth and integrity, not on puff and ephemeral fluff," says owner Nigel Greening. "It's one of the reasons we shun social media.

"Demand has firmed over the past two years. The wines sell out even quicker, and very little gets sold on to the secondary market, which we regard as a good thing. These aren't wines for collectors and trophy hunters."
