"Supple and refined, with a core of focused and juicy cherry and strawberry flavors, showing tremendous power and focus. Delivers wave after wave of spice, floral, mineral and herb details, never loosing intensity."

#### Felton Road, Pinot Noir Block 5, 2011 (Central Otago, New Zealand)

"The crushed raspberry and wild strawberry flavors are pure, bright and focused, with aromatic green tea, white pepper and cigar box notes filling in the gaps. Smooth, refreshing and polished."

#### Felton Road, Pinot Noir Cornish Point, 2011 (Central Otago, New Zealand)

"Expressive and delicate, offering dried lavender, fresh wild strawberry and cranberry flavors, with nutmeg and cedar notes. Light-bodied and extremely supple, this exhibits a fresh loamy earth character."
